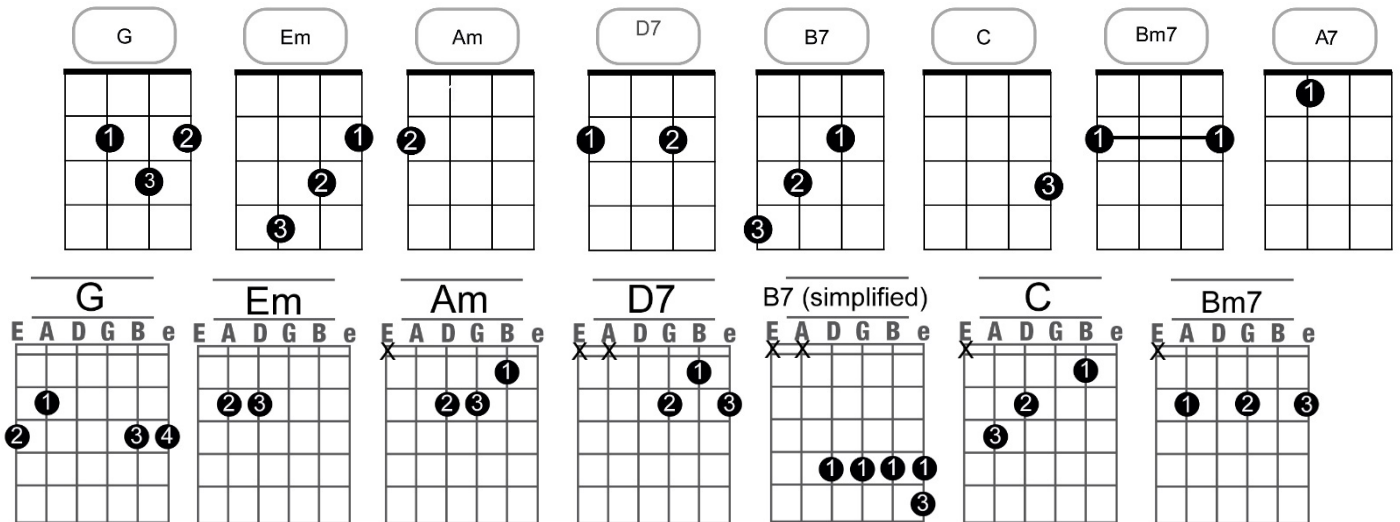


Don't It Make My Brown Eyes Blue- Crystal Gayle

Strum (swung) dudududu (emphasis on beats 2 and 4)- country style

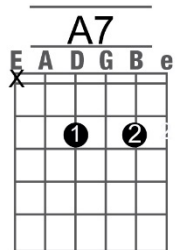
